

BMSC – New Centre

Bristol was the first of twelve medical simulation sites in the UK. The Centre has recently been relocated to a purpose built £6 million Education Centre also accommodating University Hospitals Bristol resuscitation training facilities, postgraduate learning resources, and Clinical Skills Laboratory.

Bristol Simulation Centre's facilities now include seven patient simulators and a lecture theatre with audiovisual links to an operating theatre suite and a 6-bedded High Dependency Care Unit or Emergency Department.



Location

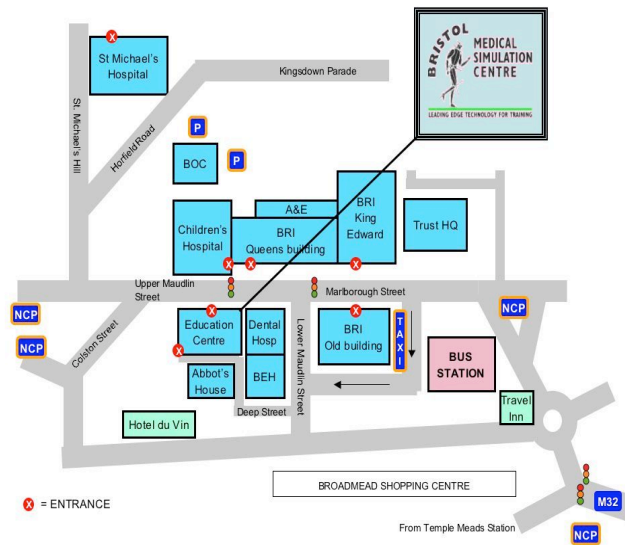
BMSC is located within the University Hospitals Bristol NHS Foundation Trust Education Centre, which is opposite Bristol Royal Infirmary in the heart of the city.

Simulator Courses



Our current rolling programme of courses is listed opposite. These take place at 3-6 monthly intervals depending upon demand. Dates are available upon request or can be viewed on the BMSC website (<http://www.bmsc.co.uk>).

The simulation centre can also be booked for commercial bespoke courses. Please contact Gerri Whitrow (BMSC Administrator) to discuss this option. Departmental study days have in the past been arranged for dentists, GPs, nurses, paramedics, pharmacists, midwives, ODPs and most specialties.

We also offer off-site simulation teaching using SimMan, HAL, or METI ECS to allow group training in a more familiar 'home' environment.



Forthcoming Courses 2010

Transport of the Critically Ill Patient 13th/14th May 2010

This popular multidisciplinary 2-day course covers all aspects of assessment, stabilization and transfer of the critically ill adult or child.

Novice Anaesthetist Course, 30th April and 19th Nov 2010

The novice course is aimed at anaesthetists or acute common stem trainees in their first 15 months of training. The one day course covers management of critical incidents with a focus on airway, respiratory, and cardiovascular problems.

OSCEs for Primary FRCA 8th January and 7th May 2010

This course has 16-20 stations and gives the candidate a chance to prepare for the primary FRCA OSCE examination. All stations are debriefed after the OSCE and candidates are given a printed breakdown of their own performance.

Paediatric Anaesthesia Refresher Course, 11th March 2010

A one day course for trainees and consultants who do not have a large commitment to paediatric anaesthesia.

SATS Difficult Airway Course, 19th March 2010

A one day course aimed at reinforcing the Difficult Airway Society Algorithms and helps to develop the skills which assist you in managing difficult airway intubation.

Training the Trainers Day, 28th January and 29th April 2010

This course is aimed at those involved in education using full body simulators as tools. The day covers basic training in the use of SimMan, ECS, and HAL, including practical sessions on the use of static and dynamic scenario scripting, and faculty management

Senior Anaesthetists Refresher course, 21st January 2010

A one day course for consultant anaesthetists and SAS doctors exploring uncommon emergencies.

Paediatric ODP Study Day, 10th February 2010

Provides the opportunity for ODPs and anaesthetic nurses to learn how to respond to common and uncommon emergencies.

Paediatric Recovery Day, 15th January 2010

Ideally suited to recovery staff, this course offers delegates the opportunity to respond to common and uncommon emergencies

Transport of the Critically Ill Patient –For Nurses

27th May 2010

Ideally suited to Nurses and ODPs working in critical care, emergency care and theatres.
